## **Goldenberg Rosenthal, LLP Named One of Pennsylvania's Best Places To Work**

The PA Best Places is a public/private partnership of Team Pennsylvania Foundation, the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development, the Pennsylvania Chamber of Business and Industry, and the Central Penn Business Journal. The goal of the program is to recognize Pennsylvania's best employment opportunities and to distinguish businesses that have had a positive impact on the state's economy and continued to retain a talented workforce.

Combined scores of employee surveys determined the top companies and the final rankings. Twenty-five percent of the score was based on the company's workplace policies, practices, philosophy, systems and demographics. The remaining 75 percent was

garnered from employee surveys. Nearly 20,000 Pennsylvania employees participated in the survey on behalf of their companies.
